By entering into this competition, entrants expressly consent to the competition organizers, their agents and/or representatives, storing, sharing and using the personal information submitted with this entry for the purpose of administering the competition and in accordance with the respective privacy policies of the competition organizers unless the entrant otherwise agrees.

ELIGIBILITY

Competition is open to all Canadian students enrolled in a recognized Canadian College or University (excluding Quebec). Agents, representatives and employees of the competition organizers and their immediate family members are excluded from entering. Entrants must be 18 or older.

Package designs that are not an original creation of the person submitting it, or which are illegal, defamatory or in any way obscene, all as determined solely by the competition organizers, will be disqualified.

PRIZES TO BE AWARDED

Financial awards will be given as follows: 1st place – CDN \$3,000; 2nd place – CDN \$2,000; 3rd place – CDN \$1,000. All participating academic institutions will receive a financial grant of \$400.00 per institution. Odds of your entry being selected by the judging panel depends on the number and calibre of entries received.
