



# PAC WSIB Safety Group members receive an honours safety report card

while clawing back 4.47% of 2009 premiums

These exceptional safety record achievements have also been awarded a collective real dollar rebate of \$593,493.36 for the year. Since the inception of the program the PAC Safety Group has returned over \$4,544,350 to participants.

In light of the recent WSIB decision to readjust the NEER billing system to require Schedule 1 employers to carry workplace accident costs on their NEER statements for an additional year (formally three now four years) effective Dec 31/10

and raise or hold static 2011 rate group, it has become increasingly important for Ontario industry to exert strong, downward pressure to reduce workplace accidents. The safety group program is seen as an avenue for accomplishing this goal.

Throughout the annual program, PAC Safety Group members learn to improve accident investigation procedures, identify and eliminate workplace hazards, improve return to work protocols, and carefully monitor accident cost and NEER billing statements.

PAC Safety Group members enjoy the opportunity to send employees to attend up to five lectures offered by experts from many walks of industry all for the one price of annual membership fees. In 2010 members heard lectures from a variety of experts in the field of Violence and Harassment, MOL Blitzes and Ticketing, Hazard Recognition, and Safe Racking. Since 2002, PAC offers membership fees at average to below average rates charged by many other safety groups in Ontario.
