CONDENSED COMPETITION RULES

By entering into this competition, the entrant acknowledges and agrees that the competition organizers shall be the sole owners of all rights worldwide in any new design, concept, shape, or other intellectual property rights, including copyrights or know-how created or produced by the entrant as part of this competition and that the entrant agrees to sign any reasonable additional documentation giving effect to this acknowledgment of ownership and waives all moral rights in and to the package design in favour of the competition organizers.

By entering into this competition, entrants expressly consent to the competition organizers, their agents and/or representatives, storing, sharing and using the personal information submitted with this entry for the purpose of administering the competition and in accordance with the respective privacy policies of the competition organizers unless the entrant otherwise agrees.

ELIGIBILITY

Competition is open to all Ontario students enrolled in a recognized Ontario College or University. Entrants must be 18 or older. Agents, representatives and employees of the competition organizers and judging panel, and their immediate family and household members are excluded from entering.

Package designs that are not an original creation of the entrant, or which are illegal, defamatory or in any way obscene, all as determined solely by the competition organizers, will be disqualified.

PRIZES TO BE AWARDED

Financial awards will be given as follows: 1st place – CDN \$3,000; 2nd place – CDN \$2,000; 3rd place – CDN \$1,000.

All participating academic institutions will receive a single financial grant of \$400 or one 2012 PAC Membership. Odds of winning depend on the number and calibre of entries received as determined by the judging panel.
