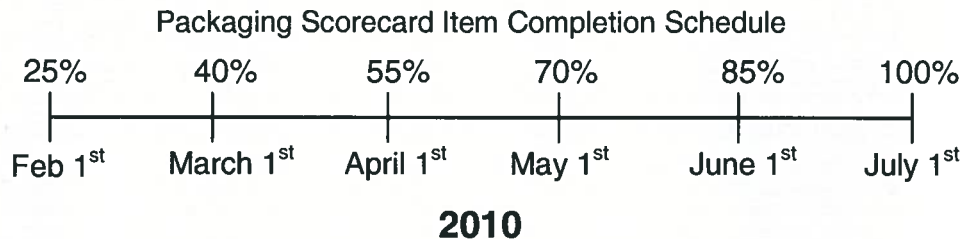


Dear Walmart Canada Vendors and Buyers,


At Walmart Canada, we recognize that sustainability ties directly into our 3 core beliefs; service to the customer, strive for excellence and respect for the individual. On July 1st, 2009 Walmart Canada launched a tool called the Sustainable Packaging Scorecard. Walmart Stores Inc. is committed to reducing packaging across its global supply chain by 5 percent by 2013.

Starting February 1, 2010, this tool will be accessible by all of our buyers through Retail Link to begin to make more informed purchasing decisions. How does it work? The Sustainable Packaging Scorecard takes the information populated on an item's packaging and scores it based on a pre-determined set of metrics related to material performance, recovery, etc; with considerations for environmental and human health. Buyers and suppliers learn about their items environmental impact and ways to improve their packaging. All things considered equal between two products, this tool can be used as the determining factor for a buying decision.



The timeline for completion has been extended to one year as outlined above. Buyers and Vendors are responsible for all "A" status or active items in our system. All items must either be populated or removed to achieve the percent complete listed above. No extensions are to be granted and any existing arrangements default to the above schedule. New items will have a maximum of 30 days after the item creation date for all information to be entered into the system. Non-compliance to the schedule or guidelines outlined above will be addressed on a progressive scale.
